EXTENTION ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMMES

Independence Day Celebration

Independence Day celebration was marked by pomp and gaiety on 15 August 2017 in the campus. The principal of the college hoisted the National Flag and rendered Independence Day message. Patriotic song competition was held in the college after the distribution of sweets among the students. On the same day, students volunteered to clean the campus.

‘Ozone Alert’ Programme

NSS volunteers organized an awareness programme in accordance with Ozone Day (16 September) on 18th September 2017. The major goal of the programme was to alert the students about the significance of preservation of Ozone layer for a better survival of human existence upon the earth. Ozone depletion, its causes and effects, substances that deplete the Ozone layer etc. were the topics for discussion.

Gandhi Jayanthi Celebration

On 2nd October 2017 NSS conducted Gandhi Jayanthi Celebration in the College. The principal delivered a brief talk commemorating the life of the iconic national leader. Members of NSS, SIP and Green Club cleaned the entire campus and its premises.

Save Water Campaign

Green Club of the College initiated a Save Water Campaign and organized screening of a documentary on the theme of water conservation. The programme was held at the college auditorium on 26th October 2017. Screening of the documentary was followed by a discussion on the importance of preserving 'the elixir of life.' Students and faculty members actively participated in the discussion. Instances of excessive water consumption in the college and at the nearby households was discussed. The participants Shared views on the intensity of water pollution and need for better solutions with special reference to river Chaliyar, the programme was marked by significant involvement of the participants.

PSC (Public Service Commission) Registration Camp

Department of Economics conducted an online registration campaign for public service aspirants in collaboration with IQAC at the College campus on 4th November 2017.

Food Fest

Students' Union of the college organized a Food Fest at the college auditorium on 6th November 2017. The fest highlighted the delicious local recipes. The stalls of north Indian and foreign flavors were one of the major attraction of the fest. The items presented by the students

were appraised by a peer team, the members of the staff and also by the representatives from the college neighborhood.

Children's Day Celebration

On Children's Day (14th November 2017) the NSS Unit organized students' visit to a nearby kindergarten to commemorate the life of India's first Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru-fondly called 'Chachaji'. NSS volunteers arranged cultural programmes with the participation of both the college and kindergarten students.

Human Rights Awareness Program

Students' Union of the college conducted a program on Human rights at seminar Hall on 24th November 2017. A discussion, on the ignorance of human rights and instances of human rights violation, was held as a part of the program. Students and the staff suggested solutions to check violation of human rights in general. All the participants, at the end of the program, took an oath to vigilantly employ themselves against acts of human rights violation in the campus and locality, if observed.

Aids Day and Awareness Programmes

On 1st December 2017, NSS unit arranged a procession with placards from the college to the main junction in Areekode town. Captive slogans pronounced by the students sought to direct the attention of people towards this chronic and life-threatening disease.

Workshop on Waste management

'Students on Alert' in the college organized a workshop in collaboration with the NSS unit of the College on Waste Management at the college seminar hall on 19th December 2017.

NSS Camp Conducted

Seven days special camp for the NSS volunteers was held from 22nd December to 28th December 2017 at GHSS Kizhisseri. On the first day of the camp an inaugural function was organized. NSS programme coordinator Mr. Mujeeb Rahman Panoli delivered the welcome speech. Mr. Balathil Moosa, President, Grama Panchayth Kuzhimanna inaugurated the camp. College Principal Dr. C. H. Abdul Gafoor presided over the camp throughout the seven days. The vibrant NSS team arranged varieties of programmes and activities such as

participation in the house construction of the financially backward families in the locality, drainage cleaning, nature conservation with special focus on the habitations near river Chaliyar, cleaning of public roads and public ponds, social awareness programmes, cultural programmes etc. Mr. A.P. The class was led by Dr. Firdous mon (Assistant Professor, and Research Guide of PG, and Research Department of Arabic, MES College Mampad). It was a free coaching class for the NET aspirants of the college.

Workshop on Palliative Care

Students' Initiative in Palliative Care in the campus conducted a workshop in collaboration with Areekode Palliative Care unit on The Importance of Palliative Care on 20th January 2018. In every academic year once the admission process is over, the competencies and caliber of the newly admitted students are regularly evaluated through department level specific programmes. At the end of the bridge courses there were examinations with multiple choice questions conducted by the each departments and assessed multi-level cognitive ability of the students. The students who scored below 40 percentage marks were identified as slow learners and the students who scored above 70 Percentage were identified as advanced learners.

Besides, an orientation programme was conducted for the freshers under the IQAC to conscientize about the college, academic and co-curricular activities and detailed programme outcome along with description of the vision and mission of the institution.
