Students Feedback Report 2020-21

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Sullamussalam Arabic College collects student feedback on the curriculum through online. A well-designed and structured questionnaire was used to collect student response.

Objectives of the feedback. The objective of the feedback survey is to analyse the relevance and importance of the curriculum, and how far it has attained in satisfying the need of the academic community. The structured questionnaire includes questions related to various aspects of the curriculum which are highly relevant to students. The survey includes questions related to the improvement of academic skills through curriculum, measurement of competency skills, sufficiency of additional skill, aware of human values and contents and objectives of curriculum design.

About the Survey. The students' feedback on curriculum is collected through structured questionnaire and quantified and analyzed using five-point scales (1-excellent, 2-very good, 3- good, 4-satisfactory, 5-bad). The model of questionnaire, collected data and the findings are given below.






Interpretation:

From the table and diagram, it is clear that the students have varied opinion about the curriculum. The overall experiences about the curriculum of the mean score shows that 3.64. The mean score of the role of syllabus to improve the knowledge and skill of the students is 3.64. In the case of internal evaluation process and student's skill, the mean score is 3.57. The data shows that, even though the class are conducted through online, the class room communication helped the students to improve their skill and knowledge, the mean score of the class room communication is 3.54. In the case of human value as a part of the curriculum also showed a better position. The mean score of the relevance of E-resources in the library and chances to participate in seminars and other co-curricular activities is meager. It is 2.54 and 2.49 respectively. The main reason for the poor average score of these two categories is the Covid-19 pandemic. Due to this pandemic, most academic activities have taken place online.


1.1. Improvement of academic skills through curriculum

The mean score of the Students opinion related to the objectives of the syllabus helpful to improve the academic knowledge and skill is 3.64. in which 30.68 percent of the students opined that the role of syllabus and curriculum helped them to improve their academic skill is very good and 39 percent of the student opined that the curriculum is good. 21 percent opined below average, 6 percent opined average and 1.64 percent opined very bad about curriculum.



1.2 Measurement of competency skills

The role of internal evaluation processes effective to achieve competency skills and self-assessment for the students also had good mean score (3.57). 40 percent of the students agreed that the internal evaluation has 'good' role to improve the competency and skill of the students. Other opinions were 29 percent very good, 20 percentage excellent, 9 percentage average and 2 percentage considered it as bad. Results are noted by IQAC for improving the student's experience.




1.3. Role of co-curricular activities to improve the knowledge and skill

The cocurricular activities means academic related seminars, workshops, conferences and industrial visits to enhance the creativity and knowledge of the syllabus. The mean score of this category shows that 2.49. it is not a better position. The main reason for the low mean score is that the impact of pandemic. During the pandemic period the students were unable to participate seminar, industrial visits and other co-curricular activities. The students responses are depicted in the diagram.




1.4. Role of E- Resources

The use E-resources, Library and other facilities of the college for your learning enrichment is the next category to assess how effectively delivered the curriculum. The mean score is 2.54. during the period of pandemic, the students were unable to visit the library. Only 7 percent of the students opined the performance of library is and E-resources is excellent. Other opinions were 31 percent good, 27 percentage average, 9 percentage very good and 22 percentage considered it as below average. the. Results are noted by IQAC for improving the student's experience.



1.5. Class room communication


Even though the class are conducted through online mode the class room communication stimulate the thinking and learning capacity of the students. Most of the students are actively participated in the online secession of the class and it helped to improve their academic as well as the analytical skills. The mean score of the class room communication and their academic and thinking capacity is 3.54.



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1.6. Human Values

The curriculum helps to think more about Human values, Environmental and ecological sustainability, Gender discrimination and professional ethics. The mean score is 3.76. The university is designed the curriculum to create an awareness for the students in human values, Environmental and ecological sustainability, Gender discrimination and professional ethics. Apart from the university syllabus, the college has also provided some certificate courses (Add on) to improve the human values. All these programme helped the student to generate idea about environment and ecological sustainability.



1.7. Overall experience about the curriculum.



Overall, the students have a positive opinion about the curriculum. The mean score indicates that 3.64. 34 per cent of the student gave a good opinion about the curriculum. However, some of the students suggest that some improvements are needed in the syllabus. Such suggestion will be incorporate and improved academic plan will introduce in the next academic year.
