II.1 UGC NET Coaching





Home for Homeless

It is the responsibility of every community to ensure that the basic needs of everyone living in the society are satisfied. But it is a fact that still there are so many people who are unable to satisfy those basic needs especially food and shelter. In our college also there are some students experiencing the same issue. The college addressed this issue with prime concern.

The NSS unit of Sullamussalam Arabic College, Areekode endeavours to provide shelter for homeless families. Students of this college belong to heterogeneous financial backgrounds and some of them are not with a shelter of their own. This indispensable need of some students for a home to live in has addressed by the college NSS unit with the assistance of everyone related to the college. Through a detailed and unbiased enquiry regarding the intensity of requirements, the beneficiaries are chosen out of many. College staffs, students and other philanthropists in the locality selflessly support this remarkable effort undertaken by the NSS unit. These people financially and physically back the projects until the tasks get accomplished. Thus, the NSS unit of SSA College has succeeded in building three houses in five years.

The first home was constructed in the 2017-18 academic year at Kizhisseri. The beneficiary of this home was a preliminary second year student from the college.

The second home was constructed in the 2018-19 academic year at Karakkunnu near Manjeri. The beneficiary of this home was a BA Afzal ul Ulama student from the college.

The third home was constructed in the 2019-20 academic year at Vadakumuri near Areakode. One of the alumni of the institution was the beneficiary of this project.





SIP (Students Initiative in Palliative)

The college encourages students in palliative sincerely, as we understand the importance of dedicated human resource in palliative care. Home care sessions of SIP inculcate humanitarian values in students along with providing sufficient volunteers to the active palliative unit of Areekode. Our students become an embodiment of relief to the helpless and lonely bedridden patients in the area. Observing palliative care day and conducting exclusive camps inviting the patients to the campus to entertain and revitalize them are other remarkable activities of the unit.

Although, all the activities conducted by the SIP Unit of the college are appreciable and highly beneficial to the society, we are highlighting two important practices of SIP, i,e **One Day One Rupee** and **Homecare Visit**.

One Day One Rupee

One Day One Rupee was started in the beginning of 2018-19 academic year. As an initiative of the SIP (Students Initiative in Palliative) unit of the college, this program intents at mobilizing a fair amount of money for assisting the financially struggling students of the college. Home Care Visit

Palliative care is specialized medical care for people living with a serious illness. This type of care is focused on providing relief from the symptoms and stress of the illness. The goal is to improve quality of life for both the patient and the family.

Palliative care is provided by a specially-trained team of doctors, nurses and other specialists who work together with a patient's other doctors to provide an extra layer of support. Palliative care is based on the needs of the patient, not on the patient's prognosis. It is appropriate at any age and at any stage in a serious illness, and it can be provided along with curative treatment.

In order to become a part of this great practice, our college also encourages students to participate in palliative home care. As a result many SIP volunteers in the college have attended various homecare sessions in collaboration with Pain and Palliative Care Unit of Areekode region.


